Windmill Christmas Disco

The Christmas disco is back. It will be held on Friday 16th December 6.30pm - 8.30pm. There will be lots of Christmas fun including Year 6 DJs, a chill out area, a tuck shop and an adults only bar area selling alcoholic and non alcoholic drinks. You will need to get your tickets in advance. It is always a popular event and we expect it to sell out. Tickets are £2 for children and £3 for adults. Children attending the disco must be accompanied by an adult. Any children arriving by themselves will not be admitted. We would love

to allow as many Windmill children to attend as possible, so if you are able to limit the number of adult tickets you need by supervising multiple children, then it would be appreciated. Fire regulations limit the number of tickets to 350 and we cannot go above this number.

There are 3 opportunities to secure your tickets;

1) Sign up to help

We are currently looking for people to help set up after school and tidy up afterwards. Set up will start after school and will finish when it is done. There should be plenty of time once set up is finished to go home and come back in time for the start of the disco. Likewise, clearing up will begin at 8.30pm and will continue until it is tidy, but many hands make light work so we would anticipate being done by 9pm.

Signing up for one of these slots guarantees you 2 tickets (which will need to be paid for by Monday 5th December).

Once the set up and clear up helper slots have been filled, I will open up the rota for help during the event. We will need help to supervise and to run the bar and tuck shop. Each 30 minute slot guarantees you a ticket.

We need a lot of volunteers to run this event and are very grateful for your help.

2) Ticket sales, Tuesday 29th November 3.05pm

We will be selling tickets in the middle playground after school (cash or card). There will also be the opportunity to buy tokens which can be used at the bar and tuck shop. We will be selling tokens on the night too, but you can save yourself time by getting them in advance.

3) Ticket sales Friday 2nd December 8.30am

We will keep 100 tickets to sell on Friday. We hope that this gives a fair opportunity to those who cannot make it on Tuesday.

We are really excited to run the disco again after a 3 year break and we hope that your children are too.
