English

In English we will return to looking at narrative and stories about significant others as well as exploring fantasy worlds. The children will deepen their knowledge on identifying central characters, the setting of the story and the problems that may arise. Therefore, when writing the children will also work on punctuation and sentence structure. The children with then also explore writing about themselves.

In spelling and phonics, the children will begin to link phonemes and graphemes. They will also spell and read the year 1 common exception words.

<u>PE</u>

In PE the children will be focusing on balance this term, thinking about the importance of strength and creating a strong base to balance on. We will take our balancing on to small apparatus. We will also be learning a Superhero dance

Computing

The children will develop their understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text. They will become more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text. The children will also consider how to change the look of their text, and will be able to justify their reasoning in making these changes. Finally, they will consider the differences between using a computer to create text, and writing text on paper. They will be able to explain which method they prefer and explain their reasoning for choosing this.

Science

This term in science children will continue to look at the seasons. Children will go back to their observation of a tree and record the changes. Children will also look at what weather you may need to fly and the reasons why.

Maths

This term in maths the children will continue to look at adding and counting on within and beyond 10. They will also develop their skills and knowledge on subtracting and crossing 10. The children will progress on to counting and ordering numbers with 50 also.

LEARNING LINKS

In Reception the children will look at significant others in history and in living memory. In Y1 we will develop their knowledge to include composting and in Y2.

Music

In music the children will look at inspirational pieces of music that have inspired people to make change or have described change. They will look at how music can be a hero and produce their own piece!

History

In history the children will look at significant people in history and real life heroes. The children will look closely at Florence Nightingale, Professor Sarah Gilbert, Martin Luther King and Marcus Rashford. The children will look at what they have done to shape history and change lives.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals is our PSHE theme and we will be setting our own goals and learning to overcome obstacles on the way. We will be learning about how neurons connect and strengthen through practise and understanding that mistakes help us to grow our brains.

RE

In RE this term the children will be look at different celebrations at the beginning of the year and how and when different religions celebrate the new year.

<u>Art</u>

In art children will Superhero Art—study collection of works from Ashmolean. How is power conveyed through images? Children will also look at Keith Harring- study use of colour and shapes, create own work. Also, the children will expand their knowledge of paint by beginning to look at water colours.

<u>DT</u>

Children will look at textiles and design and create their own super hero clothing item. They will consider what they have learnt in science previously and think about the most appropriate materials.
