English

In English this term we will continue to look at sentence structure and consolidating the use of punctuation that we now know. We will once again explore poetry look at the link between food and seasons. We will use our Geography in this topic to look at different texts around the world and use this to inspire and develop more challenging vocabulary

In phonics and spelling we will use common prefix un and suffixes s, es, ed, ing to spell and expand memory of common exception words

We will also begin to re-read writing to check it makes sense and spot any errors.

<u>PE</u>

In PE this term the children will be We will be perfecting our balancing. They will also be consolidating the dynamic balance and moving on to agility (jump to balance) as well as combining this with Static balance (seated balance).

Computing

This term in computing children are introduced to data and information. Children will be labelling, grouping, and searching as these are important aspects of data and information.

Science

This term in science children will look at what humans and animals eat to stay healthy. Children will begin to look briefly at food chains and look at the importance of healthy diet.

Maths

In maths this term we will be looking at counting in steps of 2 and 5. We will also begin to look at measures. We will compare heights and lengths, look at what units we measure this in. We will also measure and compare mass this term, once again looking at the key units and comparing capacity of objects.

Learning Links In Rec children are introduced to health through handwashing and the importance of basic hygiene whereas in Y1 we explore germs and begin to think about a healthy diet. In Y2 children study medicines and their impact on health. Furthermore, in year 2 children go on to look at wealth in Brazil.

Music

In music the children will look at how vegetables and fruit can make their own sounds. They will look at how they can be used to compose.

Geography

In Geography we will explore where our food comes from (linked to our Farm visit and reviewing what we learned about Harvest) and the impact of that. We will consider what we can grow locally in our back garden and allotments. Also in Geography this term we will look at economic difference in wealth and what wealth means to different countries and people. We will look at what it means to be wealthy.

PSHE

Our PHSE theme is Healthy Me. The children will learn about healthy and unhealthy choices, explore the importance of hygiene- handwashing, teeth cleaning and that germs can make you unwell.

The children will know ow that you need to look after your brain by drinking lots of water, getting a good amount of sleep and eating a balanced diet.

<u>RE</u>

This term in Re we will look at the Christian religion focusing on what it means to celebrate and give something up for lent. We will look at what it is like to give up something we love.

<u>Art</u>

In art the children will be looking at using fruit and vegetables to create printing. They will use their previous knowledge of printing, pattern and colour to create these when printing.

DT

Children will look at the cooking element of design technology this term. They will look at designing and creating fruit kebab. They will look at the tools needed and how to make it healthy.
