Dear Parents,

At the end of November, the Year 6 children have been invited to the John Radcliffe hospital by the IMPS team (Injury Minimisation Programme for Schools) to take part in fun and interactive first aid sessions for free- no cost involved!

The sessions focus on understanding how to be helpful and resourceful in serious and risky situations and will give them an experience of basic life support (CPR) and how to use an AED- automated external defibrillator. The children will also be taught the recovery position and how to treat numerous injuries such as burns, bleeding and choking. They will have an opportunity to visit the hospital to be shown the X-ray equipment.

Each class will be attending the trip on separate days. The children are expected to be in school uniform (not skirts or dresses) as the children will need to be comfortably put into the recovery position. Tracksuit bottoms are acceptable. Comfy shoes or trainers and a coat to walk to the hospital in. The trip will take place during the school day, with the sessions completing by 12pm. During the trip, children will not be allowed individual snacks, however we will provide a fruit snack for mid morning. Lunchtimes will not be affected so children will be able to have either school dinners or packed lunches on returning to school.

Violet class - 9.30 - 11.30, Friday 29th November

Lavender class - 9.30 - 11.30, Thursday 5th December

Lilac class - 9.30 - 11.30, Monday 2nd December

Permission for this trip falls under our local trips consent form which you agreed to when your child joined the school.
