Library

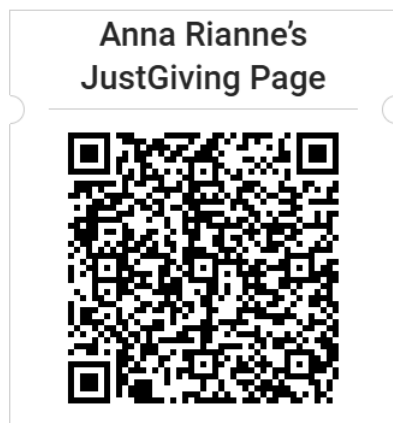

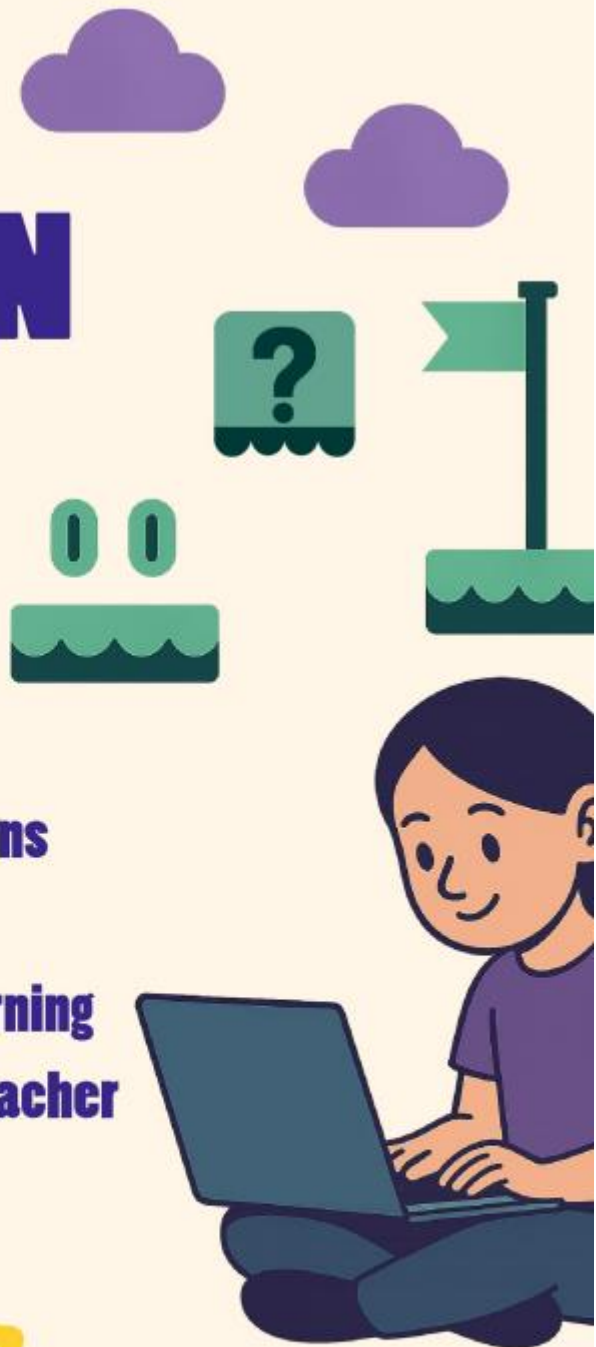
