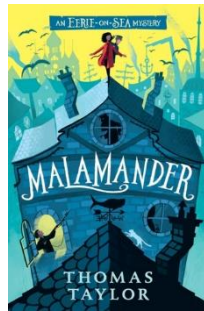

- To know that many who arrived faced discrimination
- To know how domestic appliances made life easier and the impact that this had on women
- To know about the baby boomer generation and how society changed in the 1960s, and how it has continued to change since then, with a link to music and fashion.
