Re -enact Medieval Banquet

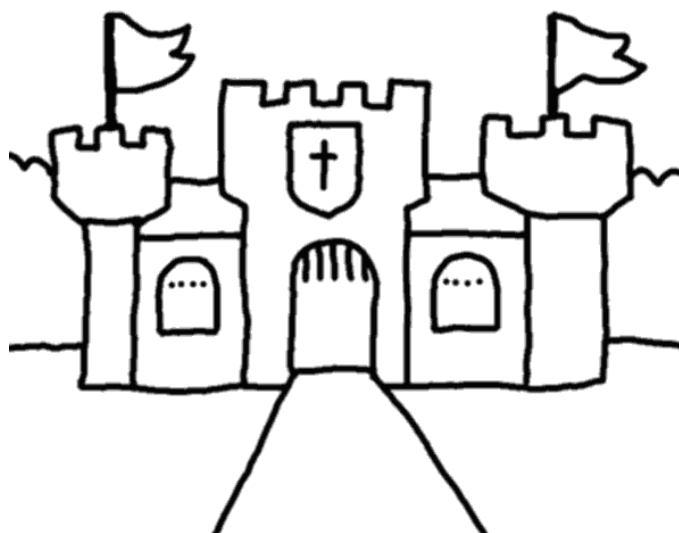
Trip to Warwick Castle to look at artefacts and primary sources of evidence
