

English

We will be learning how to use question marks, conjunctions and how to vary our sentence starters.

We will be making a wanted poster for Guy Fawkes looking closely at the use of adjectives using our sentence stacking methods. We will then create a poster for help for those who have lost their homes in the destruction of the Rio carnival.

Maths

We will be learning how to multiply and divide numbers by counting in groups and sets. We will learn how multiplication is also repeated addition and look at word problems related to these.

Science

We will be revising materials and looking at what material Guy Fawkes should have made his coat out of to avoid being found in the cellar!

We will be planting bulbs ready for the spring and seeing how we can tell if plants are alive or not alive.

History

We will be looking at historical images and findings of Guy Fawkes. What did he do? Was his action right for everyone? We will look at the meaning of primary and secondary sources. We will look at the importance of evidence as a historian.

Geography

We will look at locations beyond our own and we will study the economic impact of government decisions. We will look closely at Brazil and learn how the Rio carnival can affect the environment of those that love there.

Music

We will be learning the songs for our Christmas performance.

PE

It is right to stay healthy! We will be learning about jumping and landing safely and how to do a seated balance.

Previous Learning Links-

In reception children looked at celebrations around the world in RE. In Year 1 children have looked at a historical figure and the impact they have. Children will extend this knowledge to look at human's impact and decisions.
