- Come to the class meetings at the beginning of the school year where we explain

 meet the class teacher and discuss your child's progress. Please do not feel you
 have to wait for these meetings to talk to us about your child, we welcome your
 questions and visits throughout the year.
- Come and help in the classroom by listening to children read, assisting the teacher with a Design Technology day or perhaps accompanying the class on a school trip. If you have a special interest or skill that you would like to share with the children, let us know.
- Open mornings are held 4 times a year for your child to share their work with you in an informal way.
- Let us know how we can get in touch with you. Keep us up-to-date, especially
 with phone numbers so that we can contact you in case of emergency.
- Remember to keep us informed of any changes in home circumstances as these can have a significant effect on a child's progress.
