Open Morning

Next Thursday (24th November) you are invited to come and see the work your child / children have been doing in our Open Morning. You can visit your child's classroom between 8:30am and 9:10am. We look forward to seeing you all.

Attendance and Punctuality

As I am sure you are all aware attendance at school is really important for your child as it prevents them from getting key gaps in their learning and maximises progress. I monitor attendance each week and track children whose attendance falls below 90%. This may of course be because your child has been ill, and this is completely understandable. However, if your child has irregular absence or is persistently absent, I will be in contact with you to see how we can support you in improving your child's attendance.

Being in the school ready to start learning at 8:45am is also very important. Did you know that if your child is just 10 minutes late a day it adds up to 1 hour of lost learning in a week. Over a year this is 1 week of schooling lost! So please can we have all children in school ready to start at 8:45am - it really does matter!

I am meeting with Oxfordshire County Council on Monday to get final plans for the installation of cameras to manage our school streets. Why don't all of you who still insist on parking in the street outside school, start to plan for the cameras being in place, and find parking spaces outside of the immediate school area, it would be so much appreciated.

Is your child 3 or 4 years old?

Primary school place – you must apply now

If your child was born on or between **1 September 2018** and **31 August 2019**, you need to apply for a primary school place now.

You must still apply even if your child already attends a nursery attached to the school.

Deadline for applications is **15 January 2023**.
