Windmill Primary School Street ANPR Camera Enforcement

We are writing to let you know that from 23 January 2023, the School Street around Windmill Primary School will be operating via Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) cameras.

During the next few weeks, engineers will be fitting ANPR cameras and signs at the point(s) shown on the back of this letter. From 23 January 2023, the ANPR cameras for Windmill Primary School will operate during the following times: Morning: 8:20 – 9:00 Afternoon: 2:30 – 3:30. Motor vehicles which do not have a valid School Street exemption and enter the School Street area during closure times may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN). It will still be possible to exit the School Street area as normal during the School Street closure times.


