Strike Action - Wednesday and Thursday

The NEU have called a two day strike next week. For teachers on strike their classes will be closed on **Wednesday** 15th and Thursday 16th March. Where the class has 2 teachers you may find that your child can come to school on one of the days but not the other.

Message from the NEU members

Thanks for overwhelming support of our strike action. It was heart-warming to talk to so many of you on the picket line and great to receive treats that helped to sustain us. A member of the press reported that having visited many picket lines over the years, ours was incredibly positive. In addition, thank you to all those parents who felt strongly enough to talk to the press on our behalf.

However, as you are probably aware our aims have not as yet been met, so for this reason we will be joining together for a second strike on Thursday. The teachers and TAs who will be striking are taking this step because they feel they must let the public know about their concern about the future of the profession. They are worried that they cannot provide the quality of education that children deserve. They do not believe that the government has a strategy to sort out the workforce crisis – a crisis which will only get worse if nothing is done to pay teachers and support staff properly for the essential work they do. They want to solve this dispute.

As a school, we have chosen to support those staff who are taking strike action by not covering their classes. This means that there will be a partial school closure. If your child's class is marked as closed your child will be unable to come to school.
