OxWell Student Survey

Our school has signed up to take part in the OxWell Student Survey. This is a large-scale online survey of the mental health and wellbeing of students in Years 5-6 (and Years 7-13). It's conducted annually and last year's survey had more than 30,000 students involved from 180 schools across the country. This year we already have 220 schools signed up, which is great!

In terms of benefits for Windmill, we will be able to access school-level (anonymous) outcomes (e.g., "20% of students reported this, 30% reported that, etc."), and can also contrast Windmill's findings with the rest of the country and so forth. There is a <u>3-minute video</u> for students to watch which describes what the study is about and why we're doing it.
