

English

We will be looking at the poem 'I rise' by Maya Angelou and creating our own poems based on WW1 soldier's experiences. We will be reading 'War Game' by Michael Foreman and creating our own diary entries based on what happened in the trenches.

Maths

We will be looking at word problems involving addition and subtraction, looking at multiplying by 6,7,9,11 and 12 and dividing by 6,7,9,11 and 12. We will be using word problems to consolidate our understanding.

Science

We will look at electricity and investigate how to make a bulb light up in a simple circuit.

Art/DT

In DT we will be looking at fastenings and creating and evaluating our own pencil cases.

History

We will look at what life was like in the trenches for the soldiers. We will learn about the role of women during the war. We will look at the different countries in Europe that were part of the war and also what we do now to remember those who served and died in World War One.

Previous Learning:

In Year 4 we are constantly building on the knowledge that the children have gained in previous year groups. We will be building on the learning from Year 1 about castles and conquests when we look at how warfare has changed through the years in our World War 1 work.
