PARENTS PROTEST: WEDNESDAY 6 DEC, 8-9AM, QUARRY HOLLOW

Local parents with children at Windmill and Quarry preschool are concerned about high traffic volume and dangerous driving during rush hour. Quarry Hallow is a narrow rat run with lots of cars and heavy duty vehicles mounting the pavement to get past one another - even whilst children are on the already narrow pavement. Many cars come down from the A-road and cut through to access Margaret Road or Quarry Road.

Complaints to police and local councillors have led to temporary cones which frustrated drivers simply move. We need a permanent traffic solution to keep our kids safe.

Please join us to make the point that we will not wait for a child to be seriously injured or killed before this clear risk to safety is addressed. Wear high-visibility clothing and bring a snappy sign (if you can). We are hoping for media presence, and for local councillors and community groups to be in attendance.
